Opening Words

Confession

Oh God, we are unnerved by a world on fire... Creation groans, O God, and we wonder when we might encounter your saving help again. Hear our confession, that the fire of your love may flood our souls with the life-giving healing power of your mercy.

Forgive our debts, as we forgive those indebted to us.

Assurance

God of all ages, you call us to keep watch in the world and to discern the signs of our times. Grant us the wisdom which your Spirit bestows, that with courage we may proclaim your prophetic word in this Season of Creation and carry forward the urgent work you have set before us. We make our prayer through Jesus, the Christ, your Son, our brother, who lives and reigns with you in the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**
